COVID-19 TESTING BEFORE SURGERY

Dear Surgical Patient,

We thank you for entrusting your surgical care to Hoag Orthopedic Institute (HOI). To ensure your safety, as well as the safety of our staff and physicians, we now require that you be tested for the COVID-19 virus <u>3 DAYS BEFORE</u> your scheduled surgery date. Failure to do so will result in cancelling or rescheduling your procedure. Following this test, <u>YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SELF-QUARANTINE AT HOME</u> for the entire time prior to arrival at the facility for your surgical procedure.

<u>Please see the attached Pre-Op COVID-19 Test order and follow instructions on how to make</u> your appointment at any Hoag Urgent Care location.

To further ensure your safety and that of our staff and physicians we follow CDC, state, and local health authorities' guidelines for social distancing and screening at our HOI facilities by implementing the following additional safety measures:

- Patient screening at admission in accordance with CDC guidelines including temperature, health and travel history
- Visitor limitations
- Screening and limiting all personnel and visitors entering the facility
- Limiting personnel in the Operating Rooms
- Screening of all staff members and doctors upon entrance to the facility to include, but not limited to, masking, temperature and social distancing rules
